Our JRSOs led on of our assemblies this week. This was linked to car safety. You may have noticed your child come home with an orange or blue sticker referring to car seats/seat belts. This is due to our 'Junior Safety Road Officer' January bulletin covering being safe when travelling in vehicles.

Did you know you have to use a car seat if you are under 12 or under 135cm tall?

Our Junior Road Safety Officers, Ava and Scarlett, have been measuring everyone in school and providing a sticker to state if they still need a car seat or are tall enough to just be using the adult seat belt. If your child was given a blue sticker, they are tall enough to be using an adult seat belt, if they don't meet the below, it is still safer to continue using a car seat of some kind:

- Can they sit with their back flat against the vehicle seat back.
- Do their knees bend over the edge of the seat.
- Are their feet on the floor.
- The lap part of the belt is on their hips, not their abdomen.
- The shoulder belt runs from their hip across their chest and over their shoulder.
