PE Sports funding – Report to Governors – Summer 2023

We have continued to use the Amaven assessment programme to ensure each class accesses lessons tailored to improve the core physical literacy within P.E. This year we were able to have three assessment days and as such were able to provide data of the progress of children. Percentage of children at ARE or above is 90%

PE deep dive completed showed strengths in PE delivery, including all children active and engaged. Positive pupil voice completed. Children enjoy PE and understand the importance of PE in the curriculum.

Whitby Heath achieved the Gold School games Mark this year.

Chester Football Club worked with Yrs 1,3,4,5,and 6 during PE lessons providing CPD for teachers.

SLE worked across yrs 1, 2, 4 and 6 to provide CPD for staff in the delivery of high quality PE lessons.

We offered a wide range of after school clubs this year, including a range of sports and physical activities for children of all abilities. Multi Skills, dance and fencing in KS1. Football, Girl's Football, Netball, Dance, Cross Country, Cricket, Fitness and Fencing in Year 2

64 % of KS2 children and 39 % KS1 children attended an after-school club.

We took part in 17 different competitions this year, with many children representing the school for the first time, including SEND ten pin bowling, in which we qualified for the finals day. We also finished 2nd in the Yr 5/6 Dynamos Cricket and qualified for the finals day.

This year we introduced a Sports Crew to help develop sports and physical activity across the school. We hope to develop this further and encourage all children to be more active.
