Bronze and Iron Age.



Complete a project based on anything to do with the Bronze or Iron Age. You could look at any discoveries or inventions from the Bronze or Iron Age, including the Celts. Prehistoric people were amazing and inventing and creating new things that had never been done before. Some examples could be **clothing, tools, weapons, homes or their way of life**.

This could also be a **famous site or landmark** that is still around today. Some examples of this are Skara Brae, Stone Henge or Maiden Castle but there are lots of others!



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Your project can take on any format for example;

- a detailed poster using word, pic collage or handwritten
- a model using junk, paper-mache, clay etc.
- a piece of writing
- a PowerPoint presentation
- a speech
- An e-book using book creator

You could use your homework books to complete your project in, you could complete it on Seesaw or you could create your own project using different materials and bring it in to school - it's up to you!
